



Letter 'k'


This week, we have been learning to write the letter 'k'.

Explore at Home




Using a range of different sized paintbrushes and water, encourage your child to practise painting the pre-writing shapes of a circle and line on the floor outside. As an extra challenge, invite them to write the letter 'k' using the paintbrush and water.

Letter Formation Rhyme



**Down Kit, up and around
the kite and down its tail.**

Practise



Children should start on the green dot and finish on the red dot when writing the letter 'k'. Encourage them to say the letter formation rhyme as they write.
