Letter Family



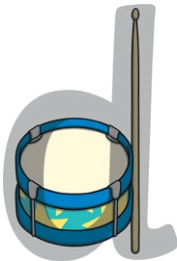
The letter 'd' is part of the **Curly Catterpillar Letter Family**.

Explore at Home

1. Draw these pre-writing shapes on a large piece of paper.
2. Invite your child to trace their finger along the shapes.
3. Then, ask your child to place stickers or dots with coloured pencils along the lines.
4. Challenge your child to draw their own curly pattern to place stickers onto.

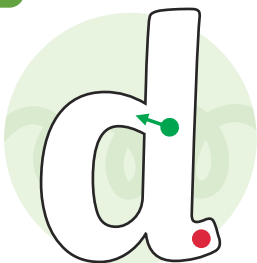


Letter Formation Rhyme



Around the drum, up and down the stick.

Practise



Children should start on the green dot and finish on the red dot when writing the letter 'd'. Encourage them to say the letter formation rhyme as they write.
